ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME MOBILITY FOR STUDIES

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS A. Y. 2022/2023

This English version is made only for publicity purpose. This version does not have legal value in itself, and thus does not supersede the Italian version of the call for applications (Bando)

Università degli Studi "Link Campus University" (LCU) has entered into bilateral Agreements with foreign Universities to made available ERASMUS grants for students in the Erasmus + Programme.

We inform students enrolled in LCU who want to take part to the Erasmus+ mobility for studies during a.y. 2023 -2024 that application documents are available as of today.

Erasmus+ grants allocation will depend on EU funding assigned to the University by National Agency Erasmus+ Indire. In case of exhaustion of EU funds or at the specific request of the student, it will be possible to assign to eligible students the status of "Erasmus zero grant" (zero eu-grant) which allows them to take advantage of the facilities related to mobility, without receiving the mobility contribution.

Eligibility requirements

In order to submit an application students of the Università degli studi "Link Campus University" must be enrolled, even "fuori corso", in an undergraduate, graduate, single cycle degree programme or PhD run by LCU.

N.B.: At the beginning of the mobility period students must be enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate, single cycle degree programme or PhD and in case of undergraduate or single cycle degree programme, students must be enrolled in at least second year.

Students graduating during the summer and autumn sessions 2022/2023 are eligible for applications. Mobility will be granted provided that students are enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate, single cycle degree programme or PhD run by LCU in the academic year 2022/2023. Students graduating during the march 2023 session are eligible for applications. Mobilities must not exceed a 4 months period and must be carry on during the first semester of a.y. 2023/2024. Students can graduate after the conclusion of the mobility period and after the recognition for the activities completed abroad.





N.B.: Students with citizenship of one of the Countries taking part to the Erasmus+ Programme, are eligible for the mobility to a University in their country of origin but they will not be prioritised during the selection procedure. In addition, they are required to obtain before the mobility the authorization from the host University.

Student with non-EU citizenship must comply with the host country rules on visas and resident permits for study purposes.

Submitting an application - Deadlines
